**Futura Mobility is a Certified Landfill Free Enterprise**

*In collaboration with Sustainable Waste Solutions, the company's Tech Center is now 100% green.*

PHILADELPHIA, PA (March 28, 2013) – “Going green” is a popular status that many companies strive to achieve. But Futura Mobility, a leading mobile technology solutions company based outside of Philadelphia, PA made this goal a reality. This month, Futura Mobility’s Technology Center in Horsham, PA was designated as a certified Landfill-Free Enterprise.

Earlier this year, Randy Alvarez, Technology Center Supervisor at Futura Mobility initiated a collaboration with Sustainable Waste Solutions (SWS), an environmental management firm that assists corporations in developing programs to reduce, reuse, and recycle waste. SWS performed an audit on the site and suggested the best solutions. Through this effort, Futura was able to obtain “landfill-free” status.

Alvarez, who practices environmentally friendly initiatives at home, is very pleased that the company where he works is now green, too. He said, “Not only are we protecting the environment, we are reducing costs. After speaking with Nate LaSuer on the benefits of using SWS, it was a no brainer.”

As a company grows, so too does the amount of waste produced. Futura Mobility was no exception. Alvarez explained that the company had to have the previous waste company empty two of their dumpsters every day and their 30-yard dumpster was emptied nearly every month. Alvarez said, “With SWS we are down to once a week with one dumpster, as most of our waste was cardboard, which is now baled and sold to SWS.”

With the “Landfill-Free” Certification, 100% of all waste from the tech center is now reused or recycled, not only does this save the company in conventional waste disposal, but the waste removed by SWS will be converted to new electric energy. Additionally, Futura Mobility installed a corrugated baler in its Tech Center which SWS pays Futura to pick up, along with a 30 yard container for wood skids that SWS will convert to mulch.

Janet DeNicola, Owner of Futura Mobility, voiced her praises on the effort stating, “We are always looking for ways to improve our operations and efficiencies, and achieving this milestone was a challenge we overcame through the dedication of our employees.” She continued, “This effort exemplifies Futura’s commitment to the environment and the community in which we work.”

“I’ve always been a huge proponent of going green,” explained Alvarez. “My wife and I converted our house to run on solar power 2 years ago, so I naturally wanted to bring that thinking to my work here at Futura. I’m proud we’re now working with SWS and have become completely landfill free.”
